Lives saved

In every community where CHE is implemented, people come to Christ.

The first to become followers of Jesus are often those volunteers who have been trained to teach basic disease prevention in the homes of their neighbors.





People in the community work together to improve their quality of life. Clean water is available, sanitation improves, agriculture diversifies, small businesses develop, and churches grow.



Communities Transformed

An external evaluation of work in the Congo showed that underage-five child mortality dropped from 7.14 percent to 3.19 percent in the 113 villages where Community Health Evangelism programs were implemented. Based on census data, that represents almost 16,000 infants and children saved in five years!



In over 20 years of 2/3 world ministry, having evaluated dozens of wholistic programs in numerous countries — I have not seen anywhere such dramatic impact for such little costs.
