

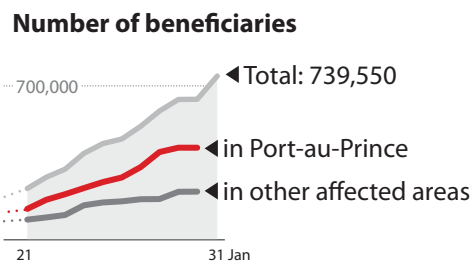
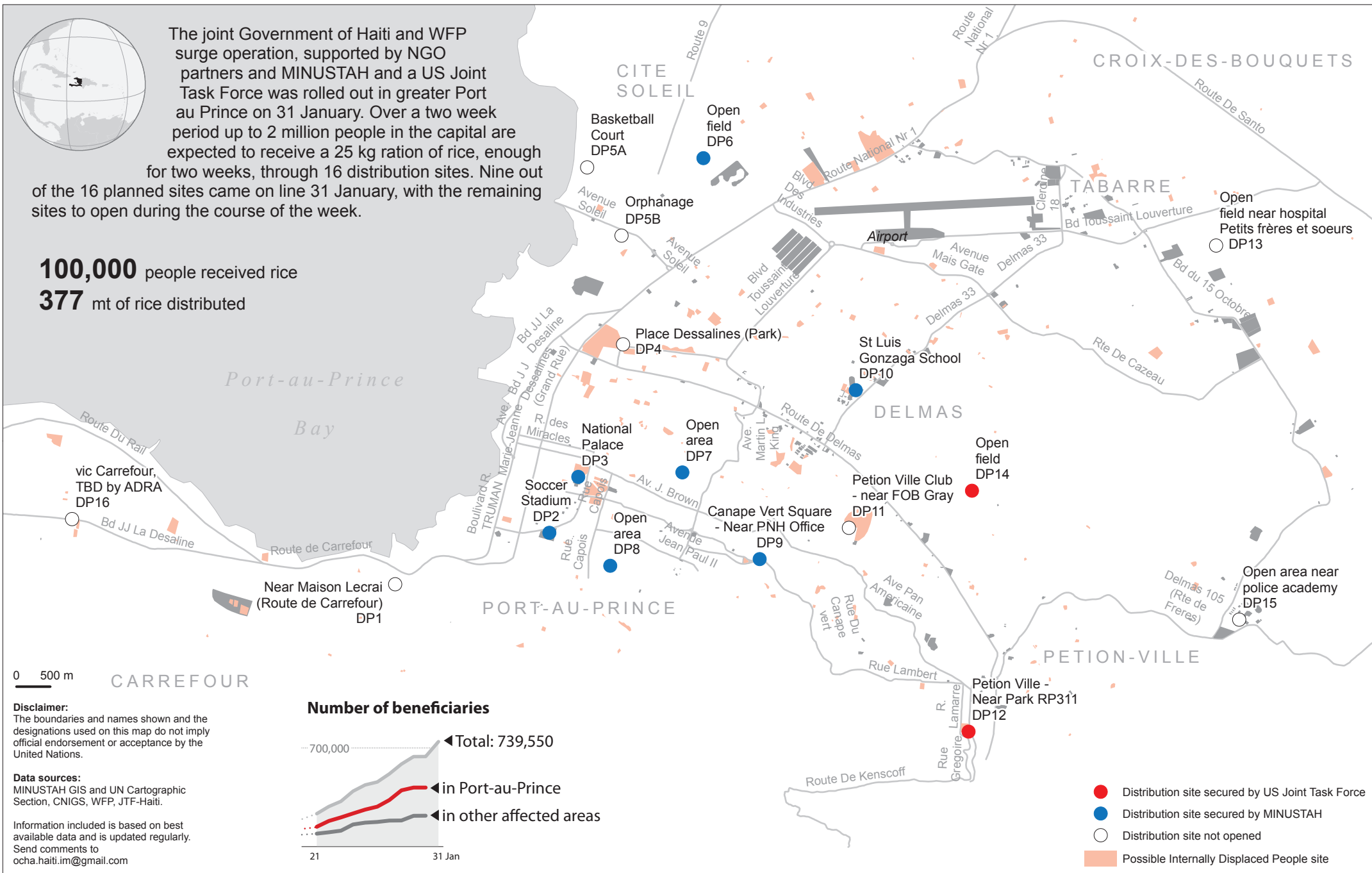
# HAITI - Food Distribution Update (as of 31 January 2010)

1 February 2010



The joint Government of Haiti and WFP surge operation, supported by NGO partners and MINUSTAH and a US Joint Task Force was rolled out in greater Port au Prince on 31 January. Over a two week period up to 2 million people in the capital are expected to receive a 25 kg ration of rice, enough for two weeks, through 16 distribution sites. Nine out of the 16 planned sites came on line 31 January, with the remaining sites to open during the course of the week.
