Children are important—both now and in the future.


- Children between the age of 4 and 14 are the people most responsive to the gospel.

Through Bible storying and discipleship, children come to know Christ and grow in him. They share their faith with others.


Children are involved in community projects, such as recycling, or building a playground, or starting a community garden.
